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# Legal Framework

- National Strategy for Regional Development for the years 2016-2020 adopted on 13.10.2016





# **National Planning Framework**



... a bottom up and top down cooperative process

Key question for the government:

How can regions best contribute to development of the country as a whole?





## Sources of Funding

National funding is scarce, only available resources dedicated to regional development are through National Fund for Regional Development (NFRD)

Approximately 10 million Euro annually for all regions!

National Fund seems to be competing with Environment Fund, Road Fund, Energy Efficiency Fund and proposed actions are often small scale interventions in rural areas!

Dependency on donor contributions for investments in regions!





- European Neighborhood Instrument Single Support Framework
- calls within the <u>Black Sea Basin and Danube Transnational Programmes</u> expected to be launched at the end of 2018, beginning of 2019.
- The Call for Project proposal within the <u>CBC Programme Romania-RM</u> will be launched at the end of October this year.

The Joint Operational Programme Romania – Republic of Moldova 2014-2020 will focus its strategic intervention on four thematic objectives:

- 1. Support to education, research, technological development and innovation
- 2. Promotion of local culture and preservation of historical heritage
- 3. Improvement of accessibility to the regions, development of transport and communication networks and systems
- 4. Common challenges in the field of safety and security





Moldova became the first Eastern Partnership country to participate in the EU's <u>Competitiveness of</u> <u>Enterprises and SME programme</u>, which promotes entrepreneurship and entrepreneurial culture, improves access to markets and finance for SMEs and boosts the competitiveness of enterprises.

Moldova was also the first Eastern Partner to be associated with the <u>Horizon 2020</u> programme, through which the EU supports research and innovation.

It also participates in the **Erasmus+** programme for education, training, youth and sport.

In March 2015, Moldova joined the European programme for culture **Creative Europe**.

- Specialized organizations and agencies (employment, education, business support organizations, regional development agencies, tourism and culture support organizations)
- Civil society organizations
- General public





### Governance

### The Definition of Regional Development (OECD)

Regional development is (...) a general effort to reduce regional disparities by supporting (employment and wealth-generating) economic activities in regions





#### Governance

Past policies <u>have failed to reduce regional disparities</u> significantly and <u>have not been able to</u> <u>help individual lagging regions to catch up</u>, despite the allocation of significant public funding. The result is under-used economic potential and weakened social cohesion.

This involves a shift away from redistribution and subsidies for lagging regions in favor of measures to increase the competitiveness of all regions.






### The Role of Regions

Successful development can never thrive on an organizational set up where the traditional institutional borders look like the drain pipes.

Is this a natural role and position of Regional Development Agencies? Can RDA's introduce "context management" as a formula for integrated strategic planning on regional level?







### Conclusions

- skills in programme and project management (Prject Cycle Management)
- increasing the base of beneficiaries (project applicants on different CfP's) and hold them accountable for implementation and procurement
- create networks of collaboration and partnerships on all levels
- actively involve key stakeholders and communities in planning processes <u>and maintain the</u> <u>dialogue</u>!
- introduce co-financing and pre-financing schemes to motivate applicants to apply.

focus on your development needs first and than proactively search for funding wherever opportunity presents itself!
