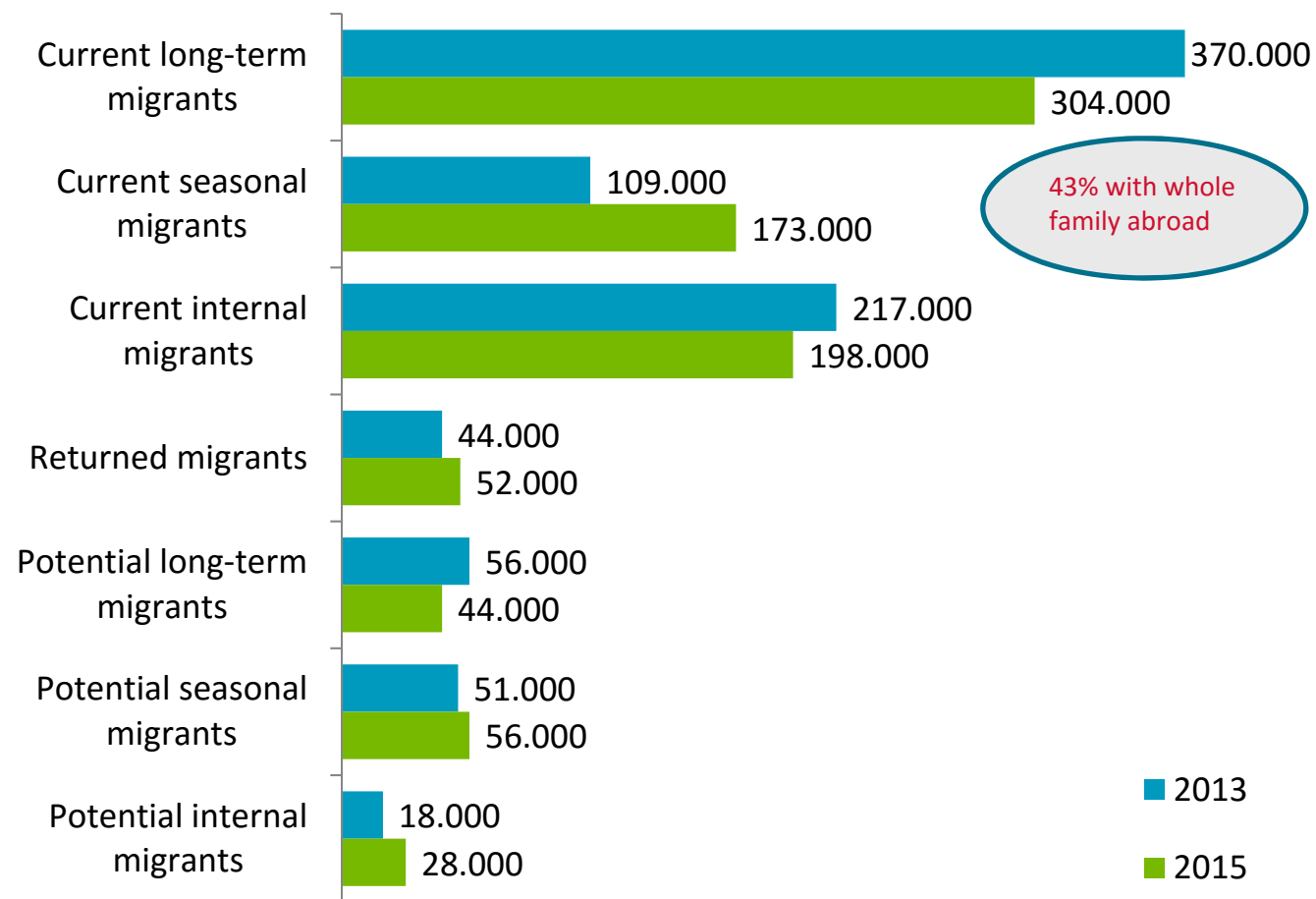

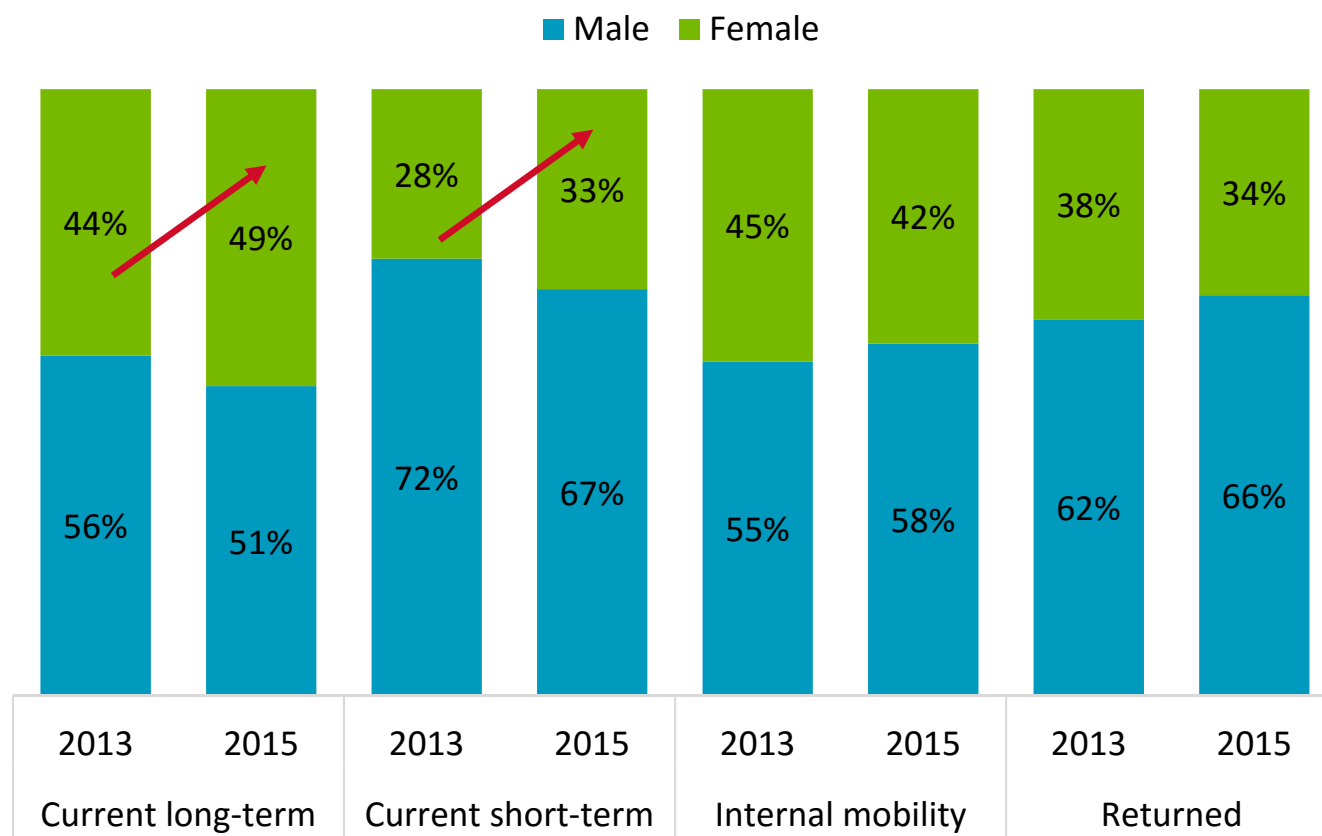

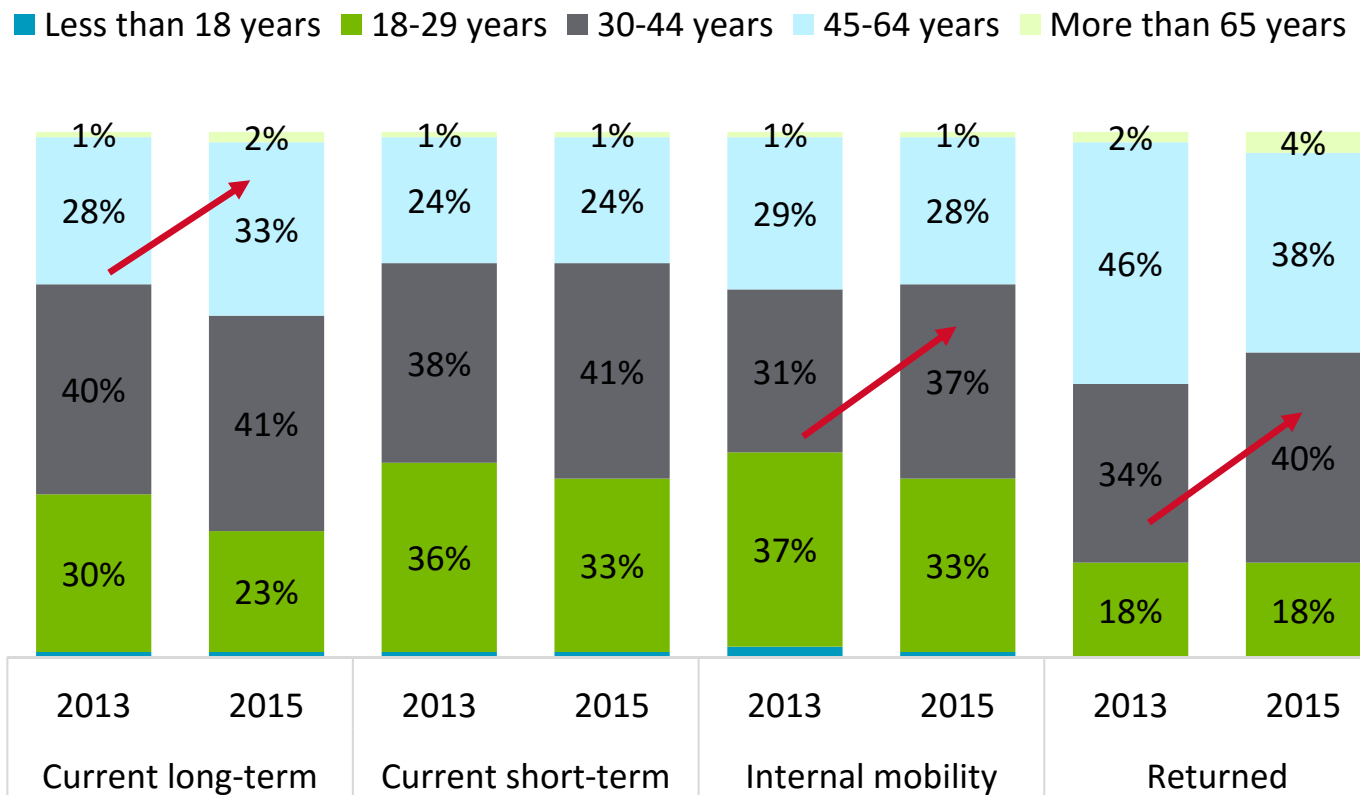

Trends by sex



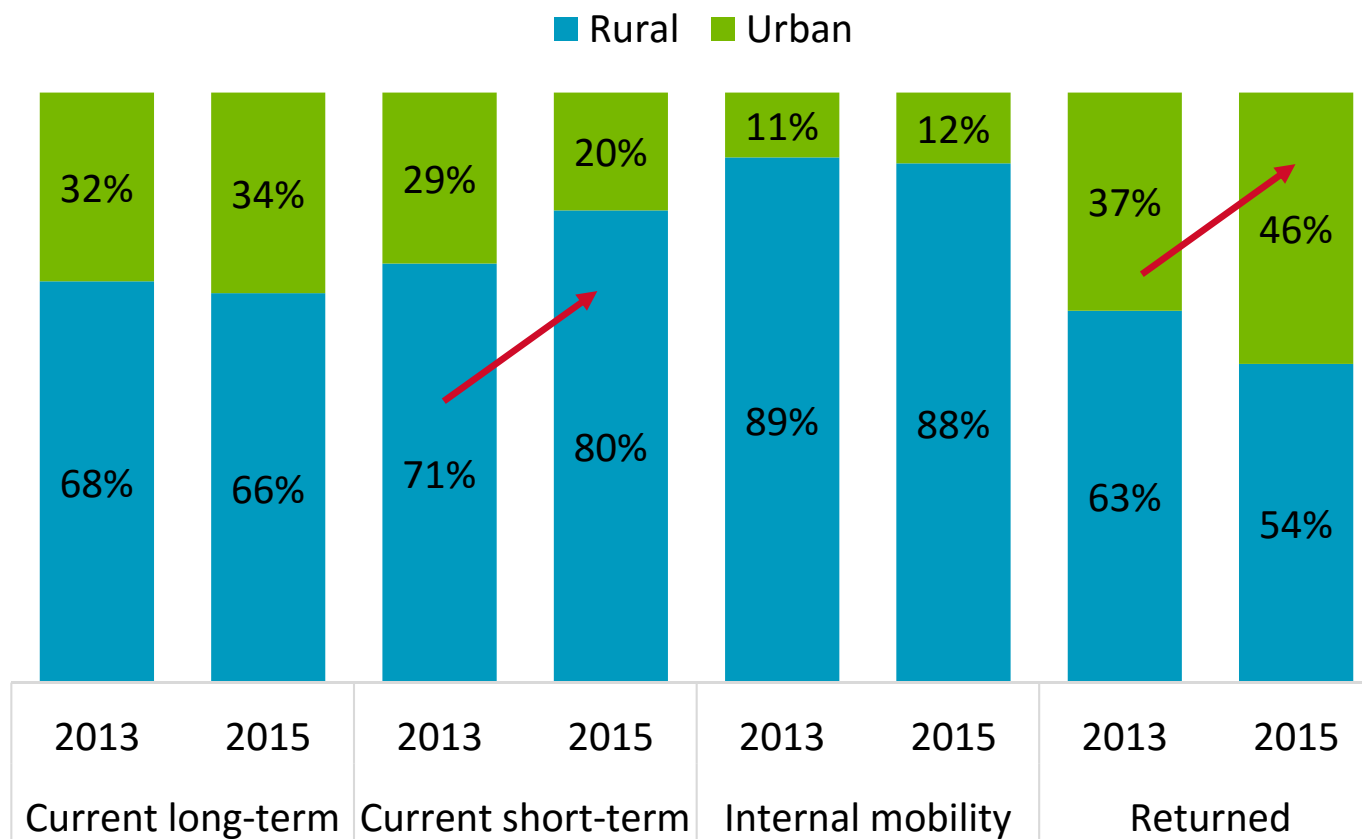

Trends by age groups

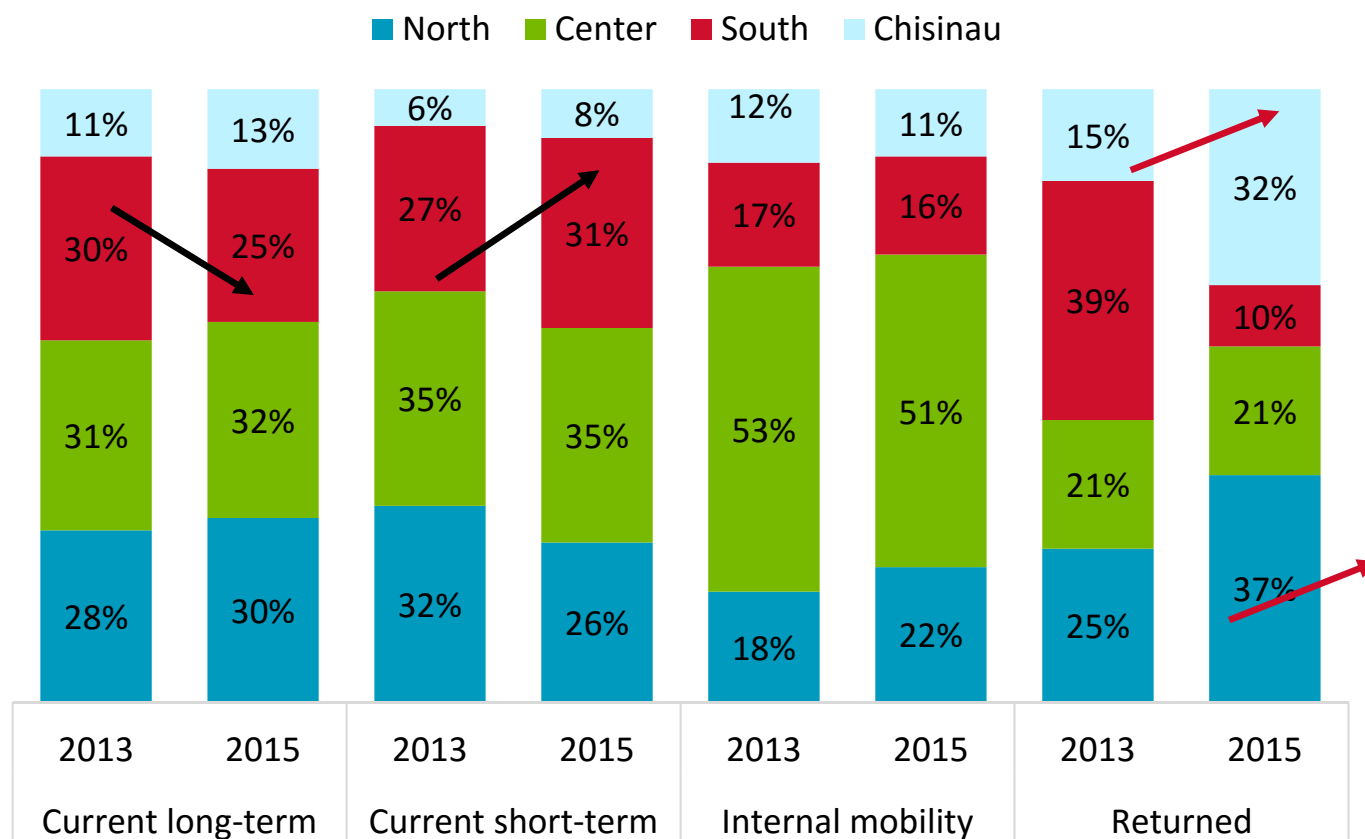

Trends by residence in Moldova

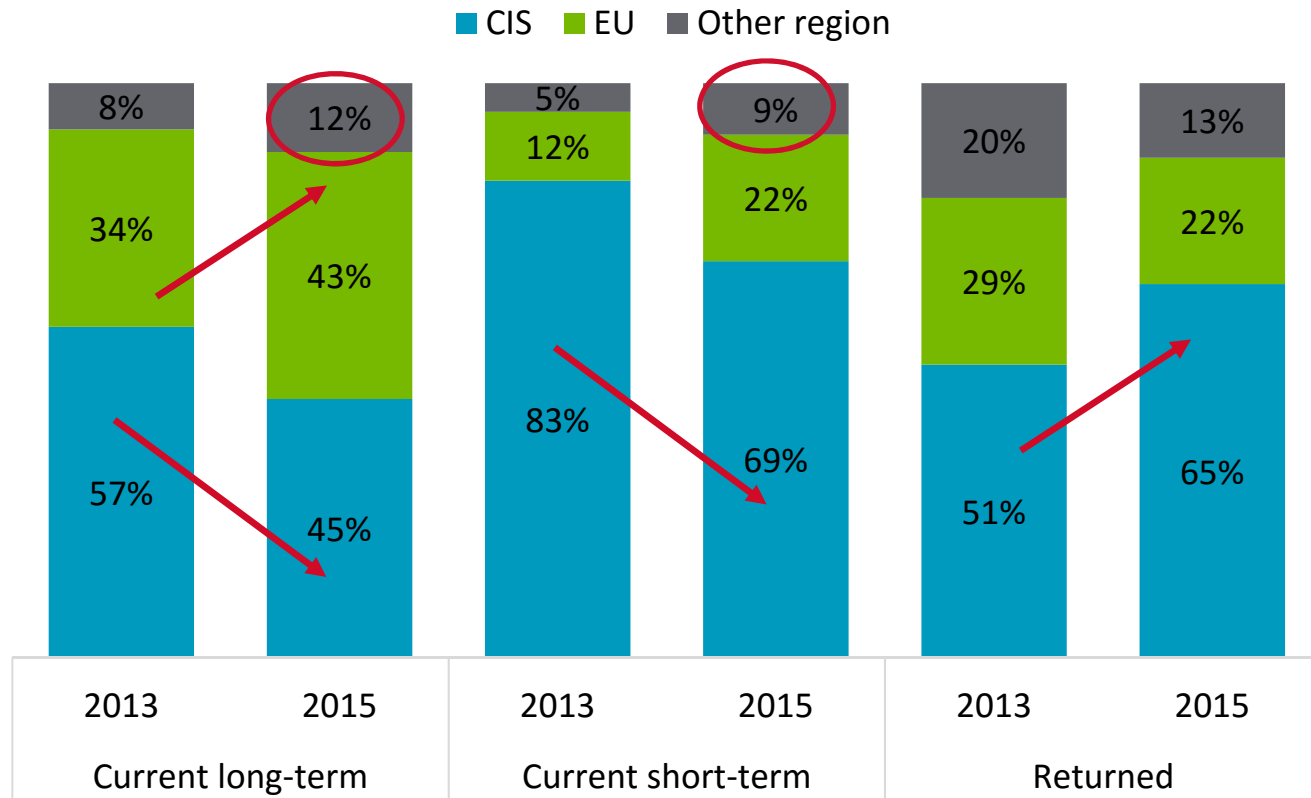


Trends by region in Moldova

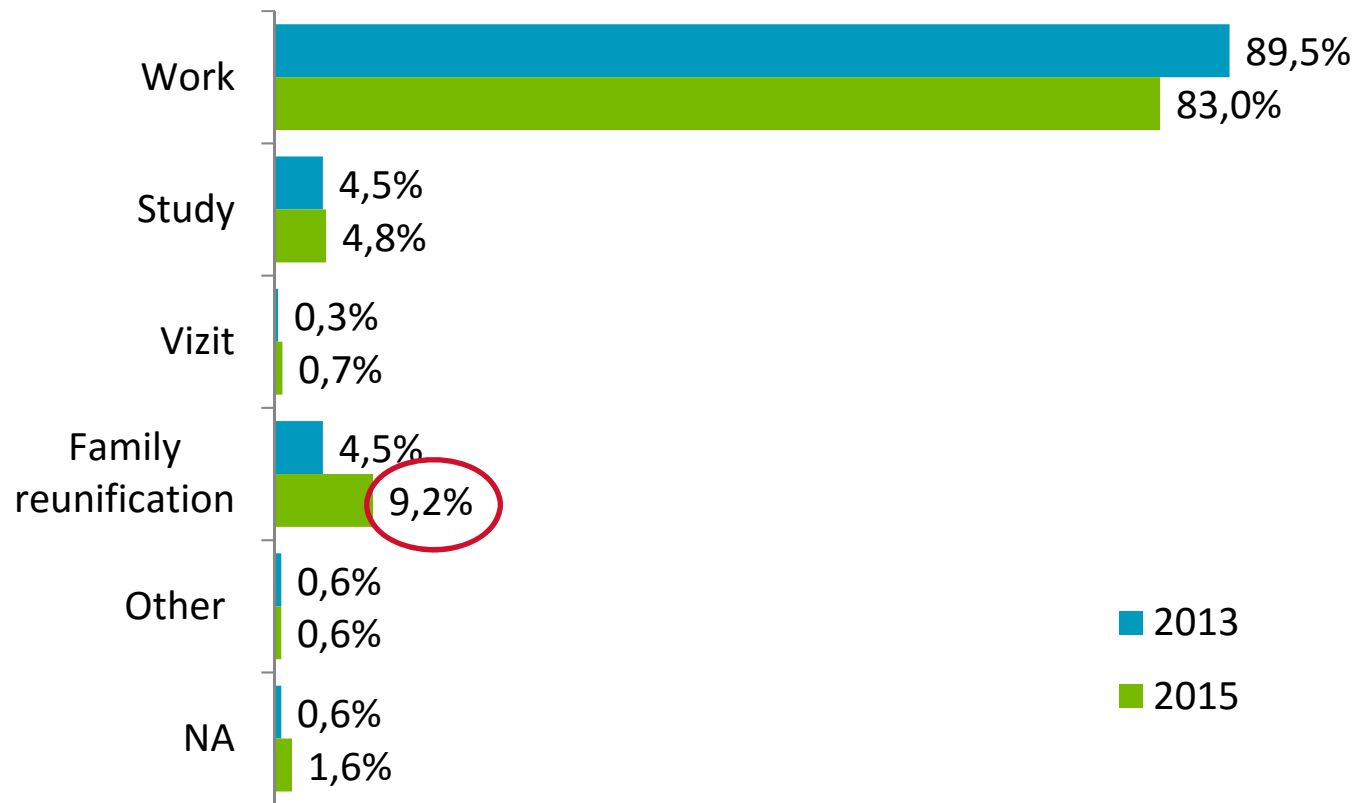

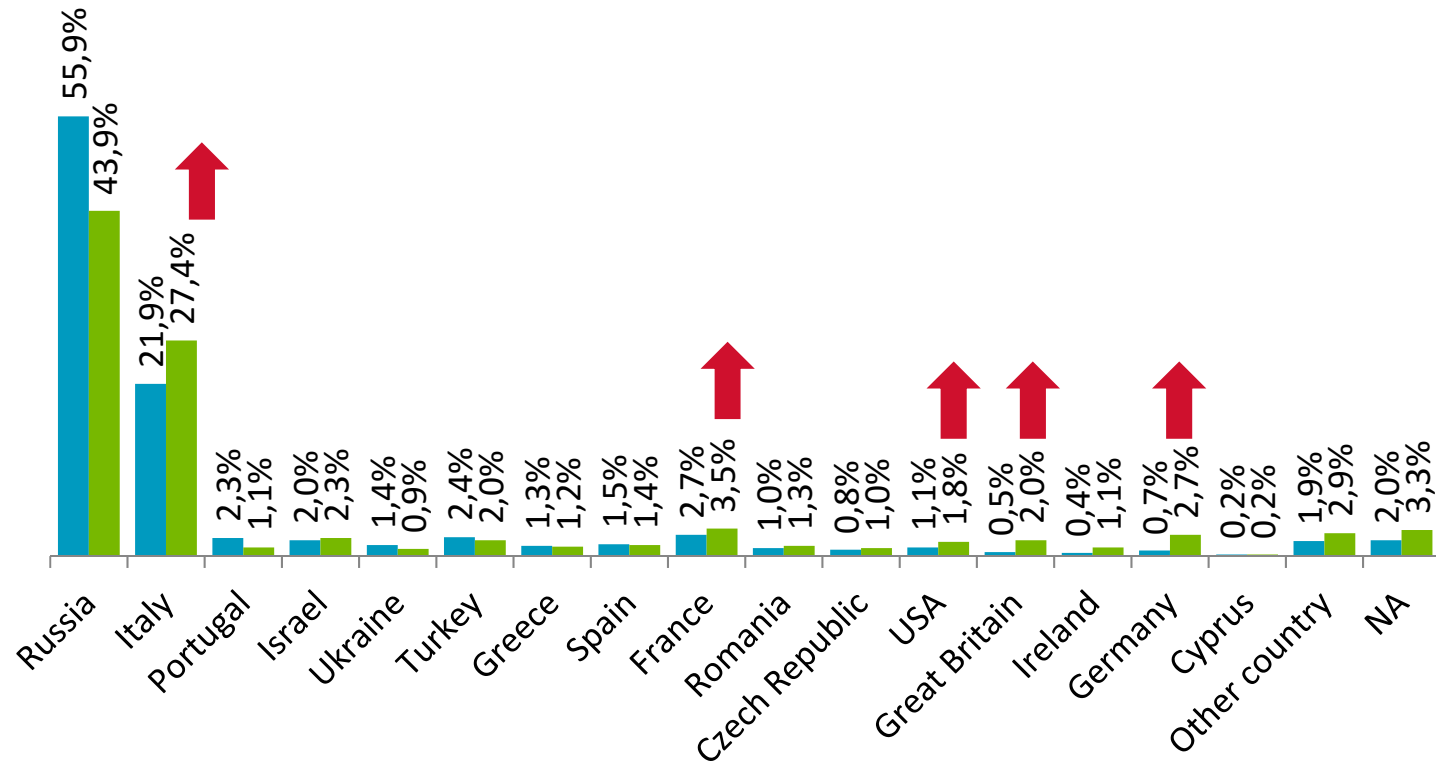
Trends by region of migration



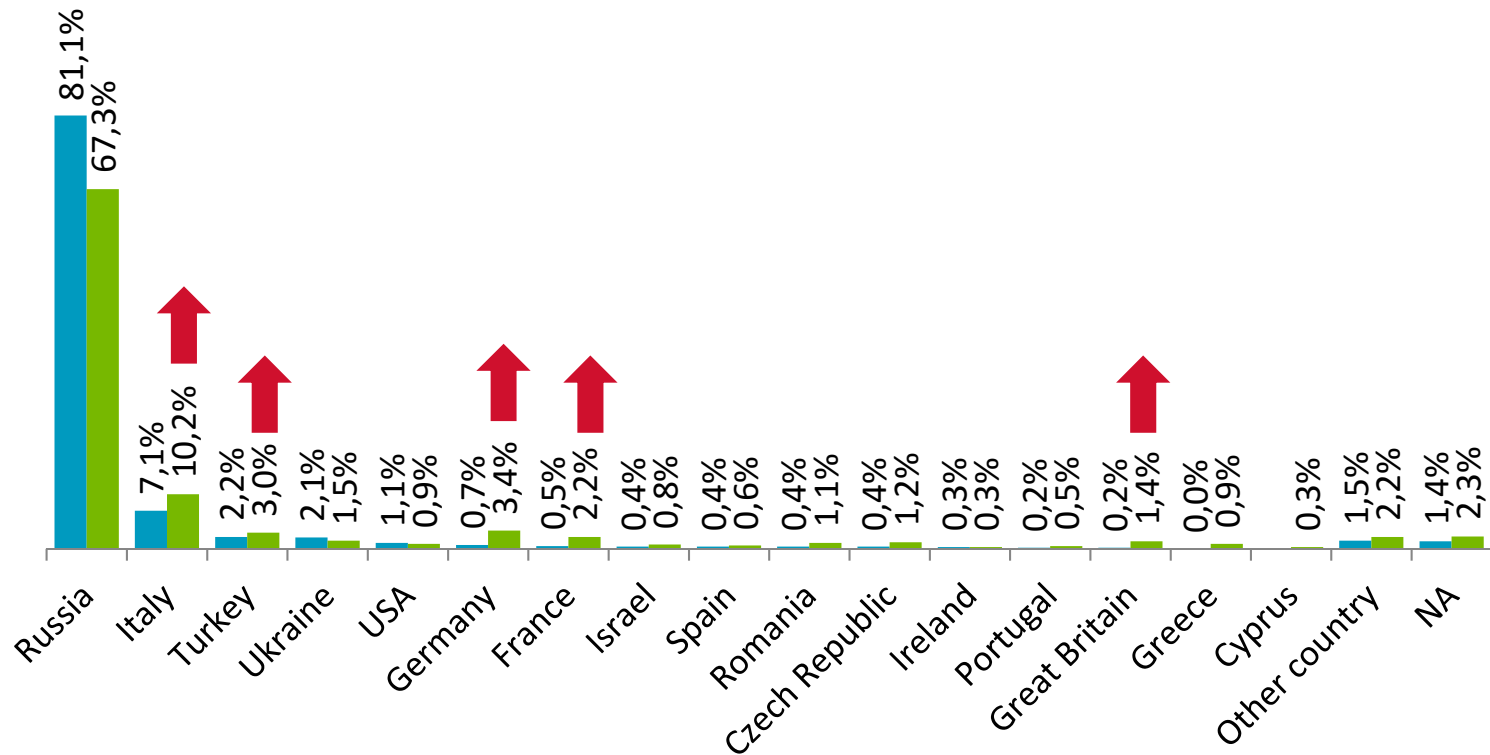
Trends by purpose for staying abroad



Trends by country of destination – long-term mobility

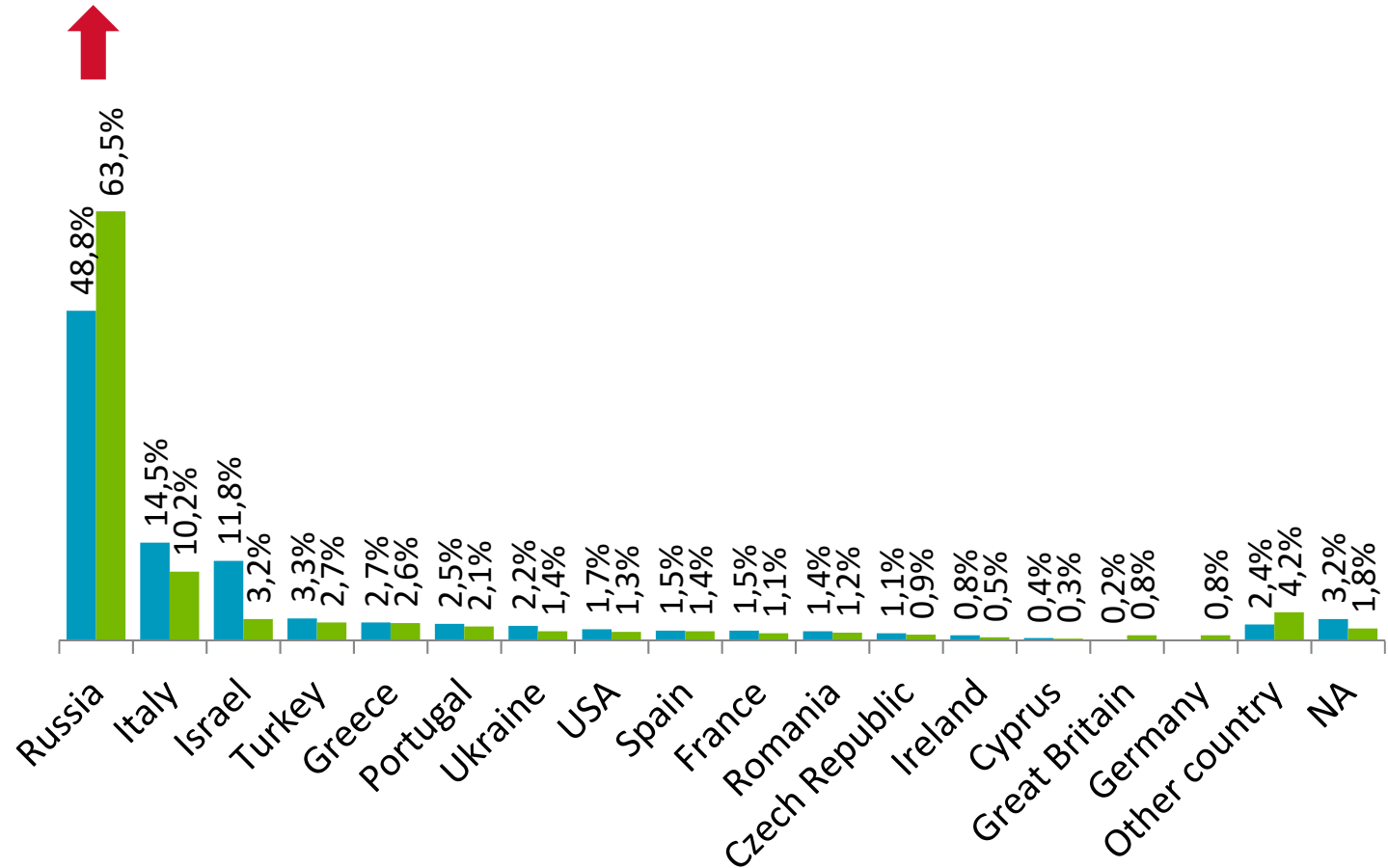


Trends by country of destination – short-term mobility

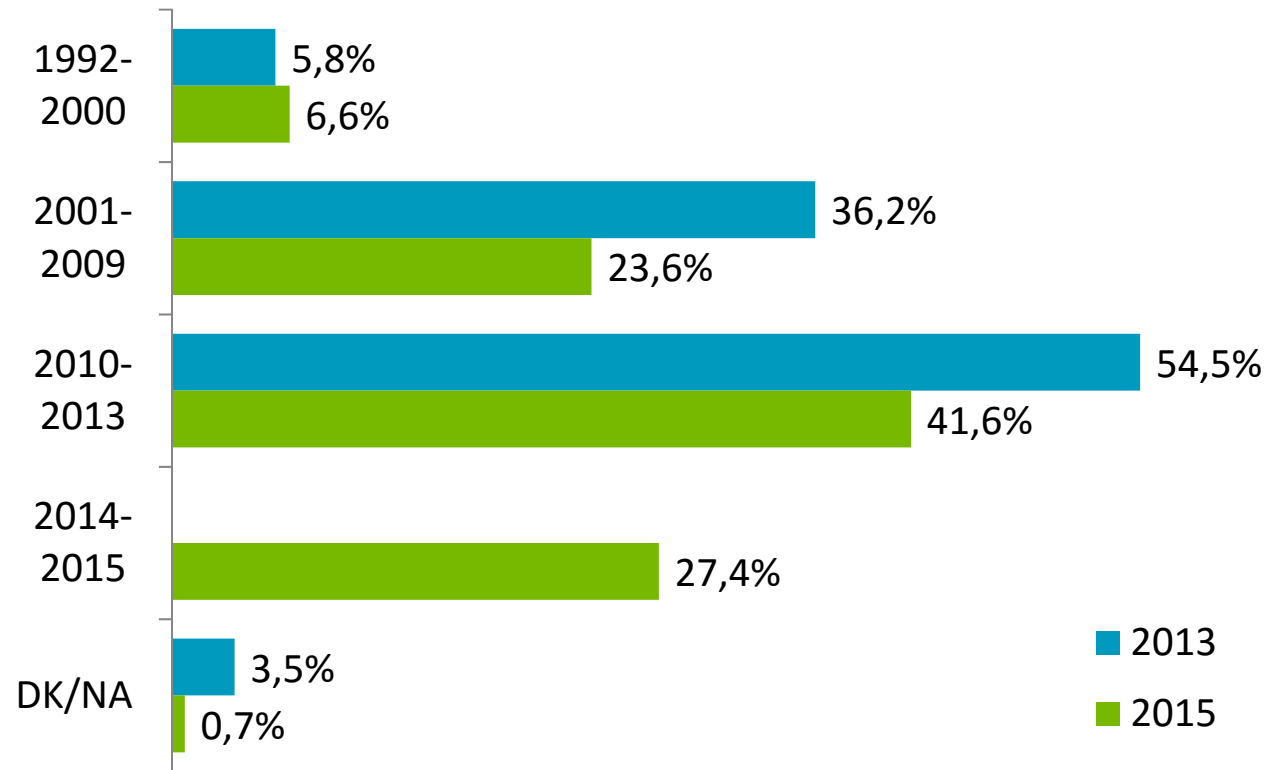

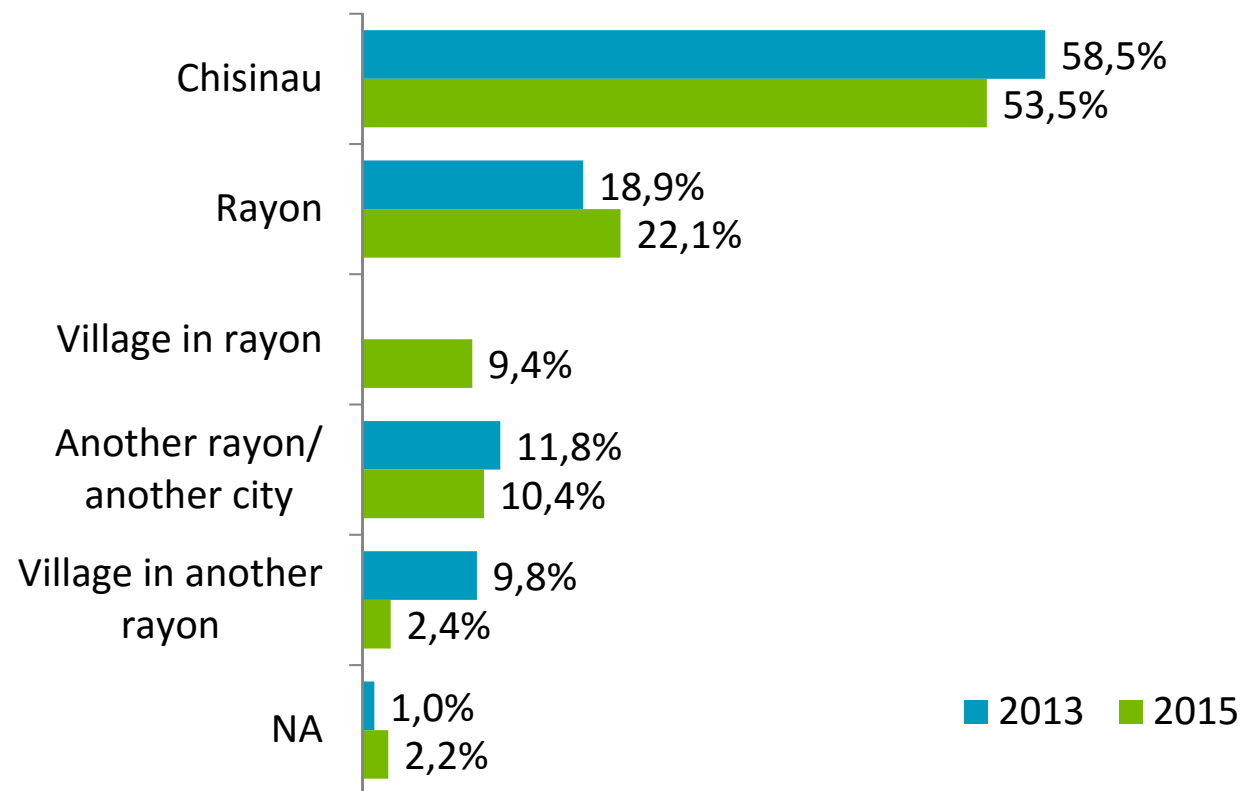
Trends by country of destination – returned mobility



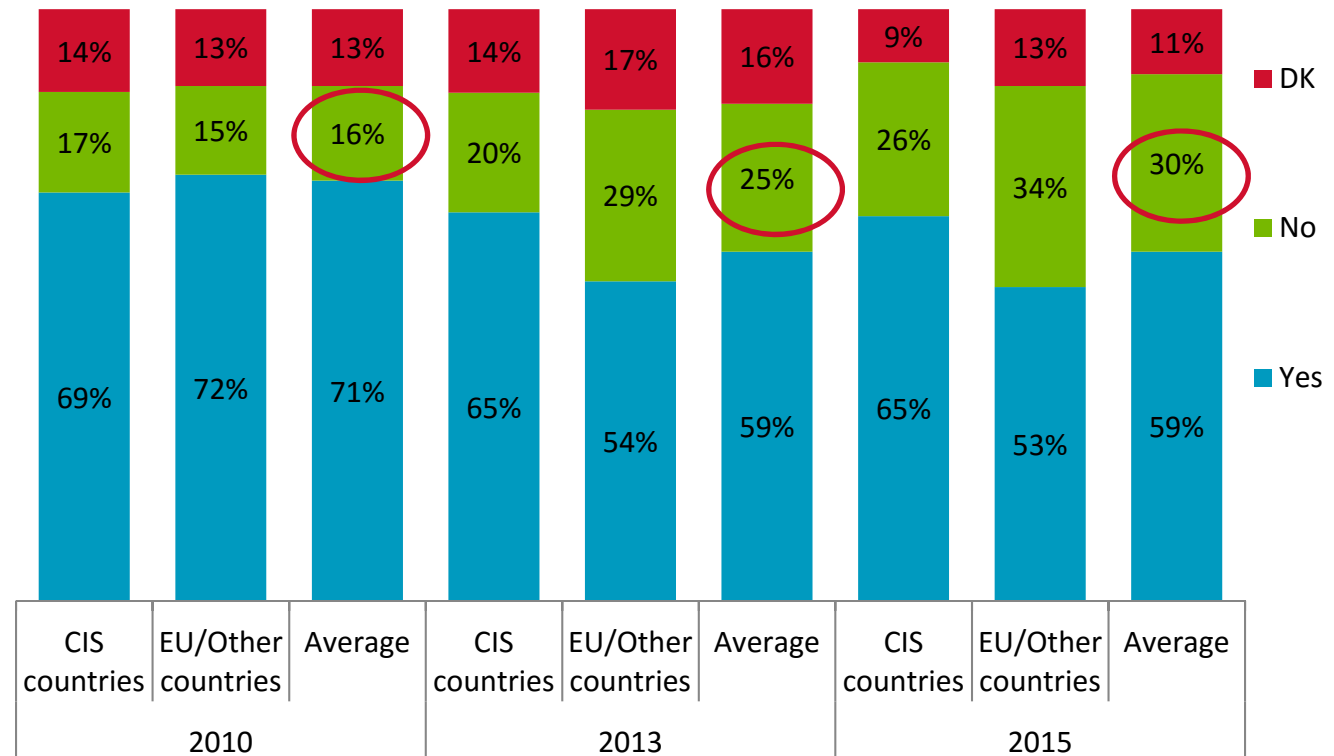
Trends by return period



Trends by destination for internal mobility

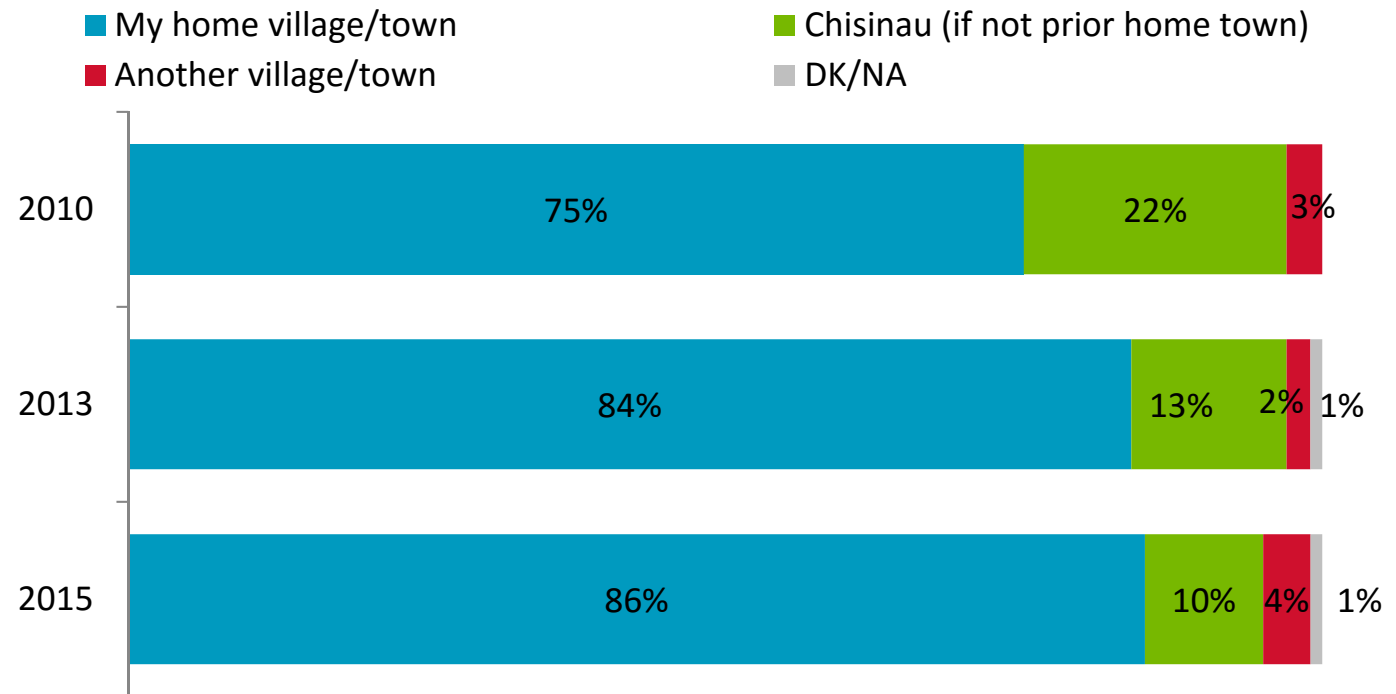


Return intention

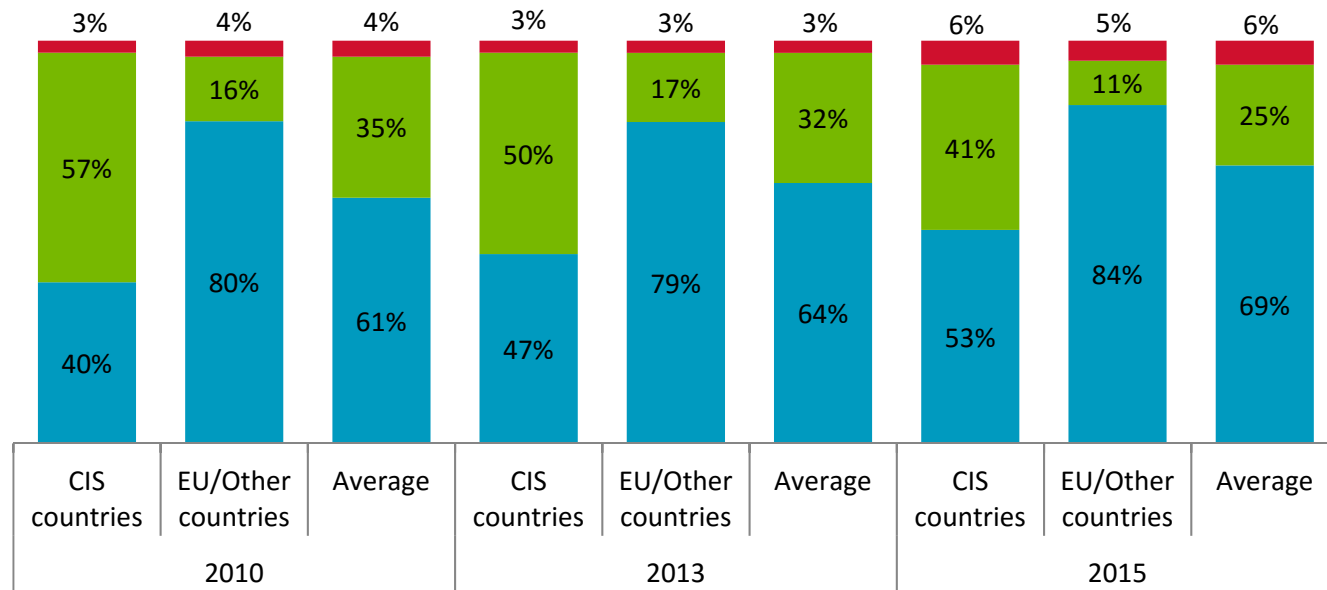

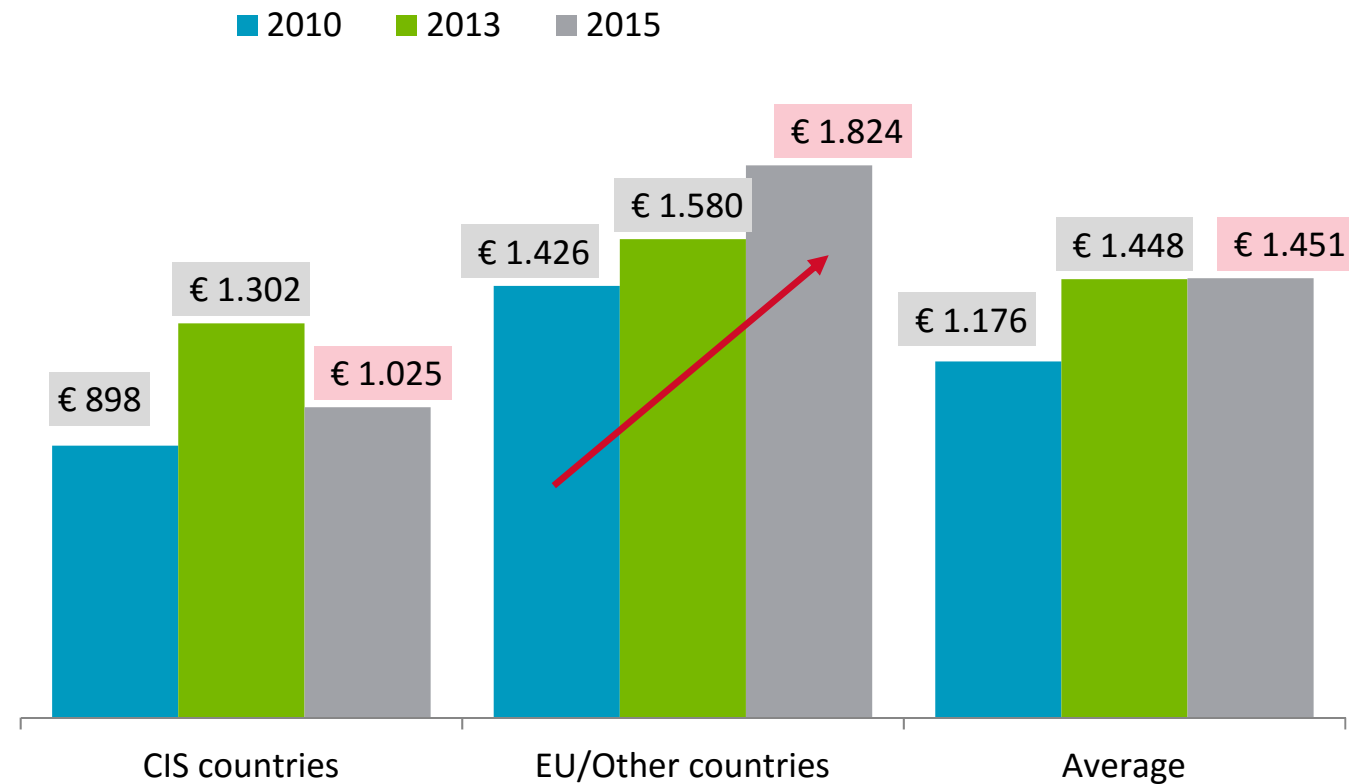

- Employee with working contract

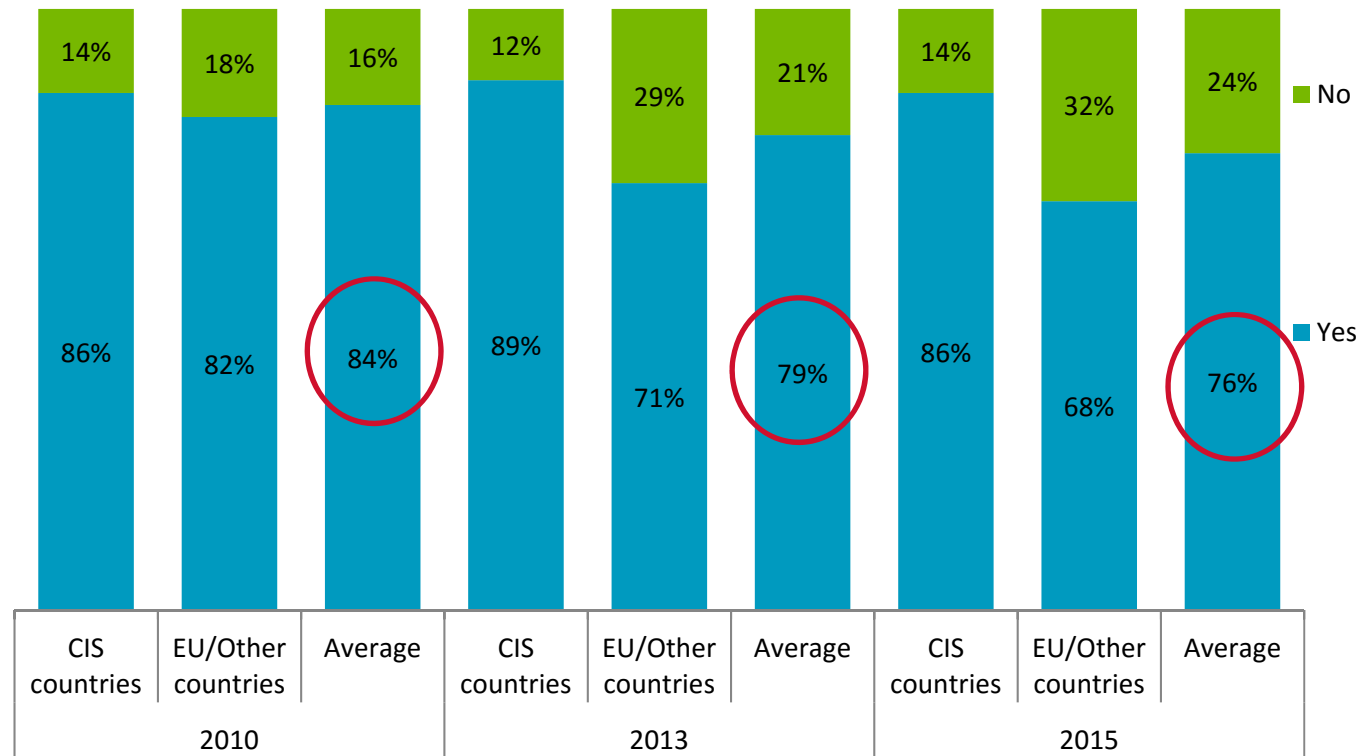


Monthly HH net income abroad

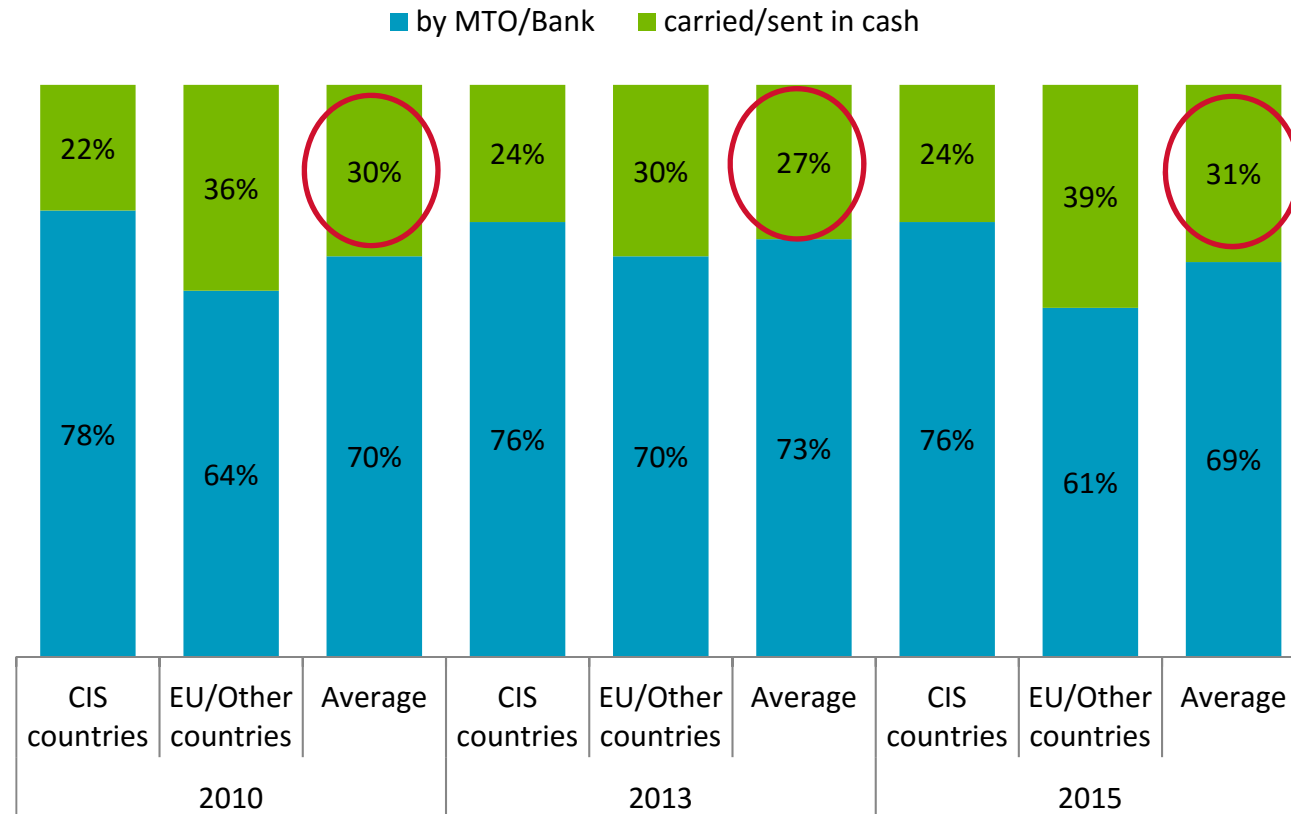

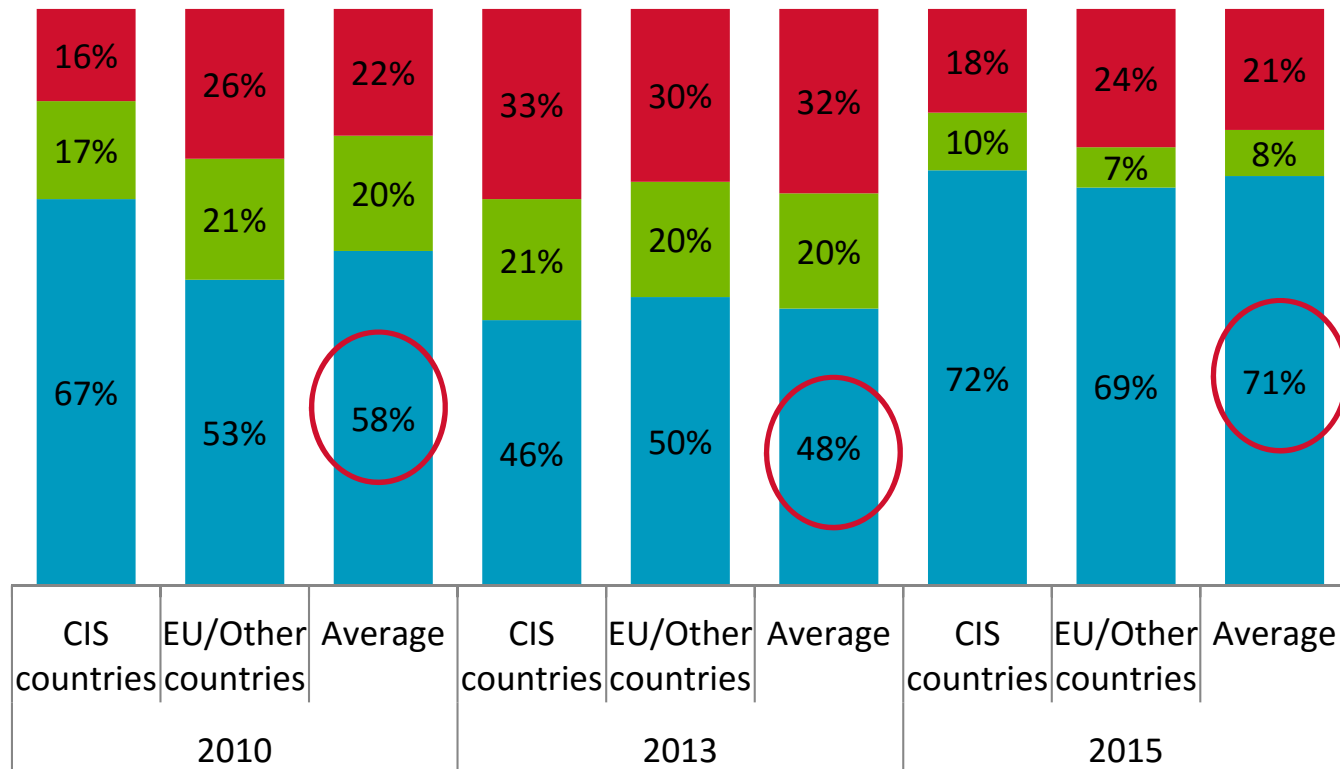


Transfer channels



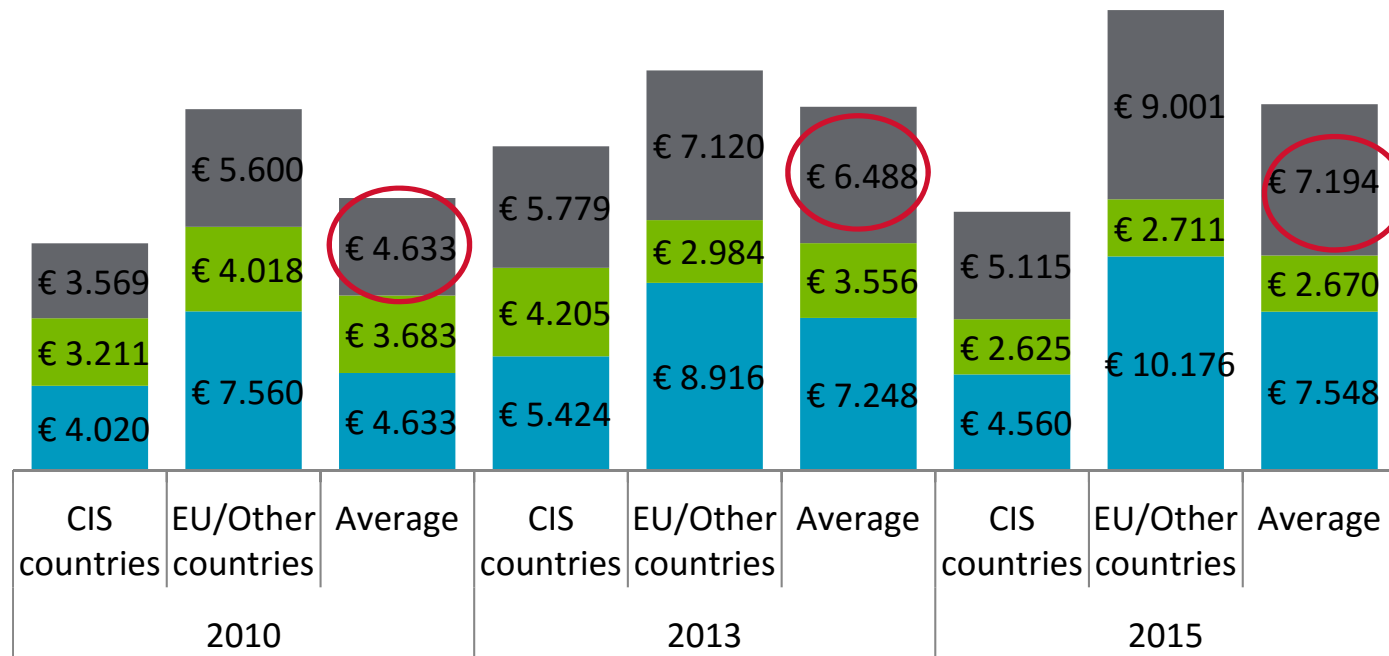
Use of transfers

■ Consumed ■ Saved ■ Invested

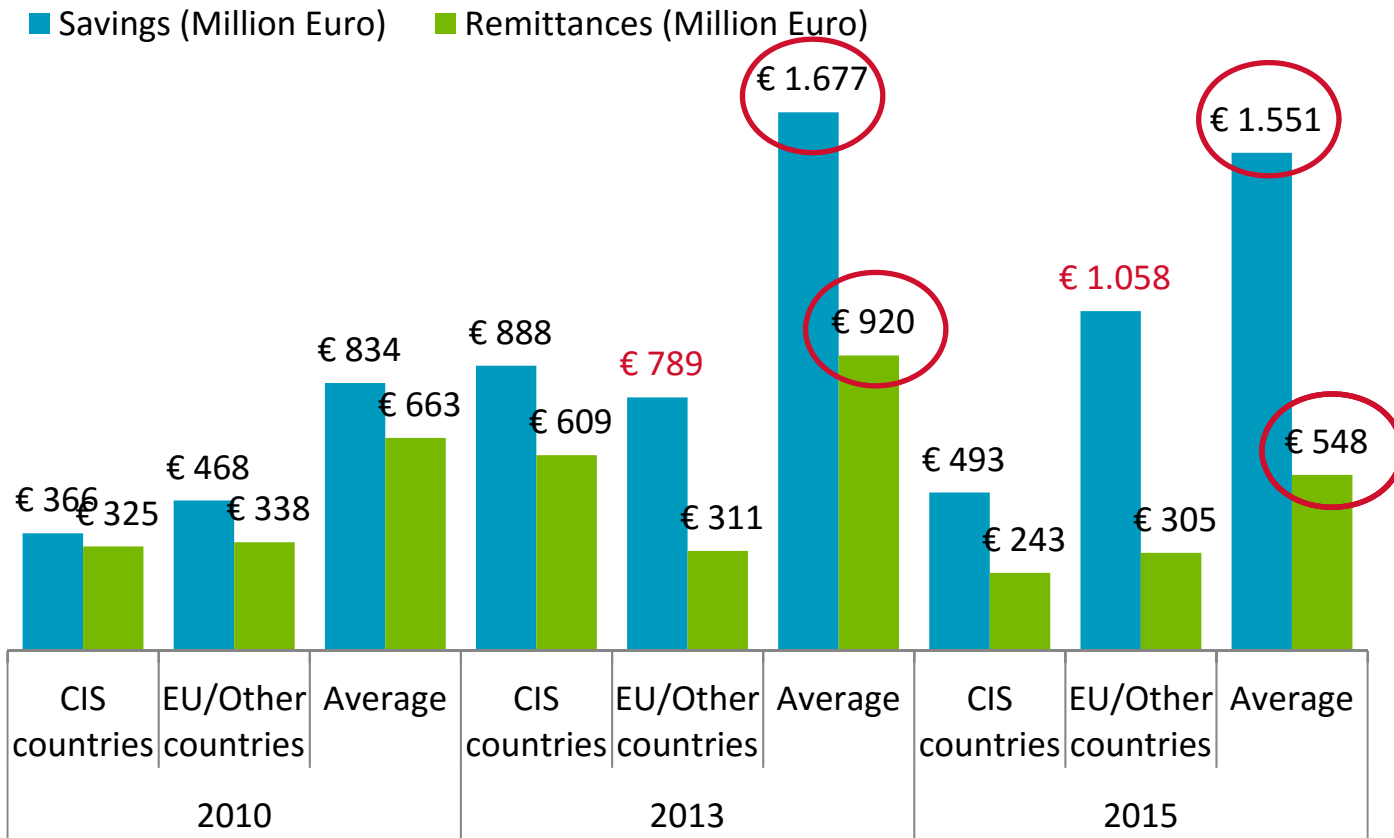


Annual expenditures, remittances, savings

■ Annual HH Consumption ■ Annual HH Remittance Value ■ Annual NET HH Savings



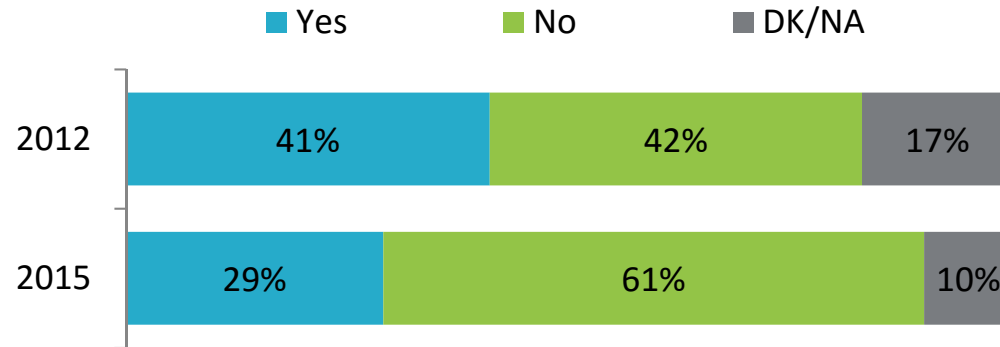
Annual savings and remittances values (from long-term migrants only)



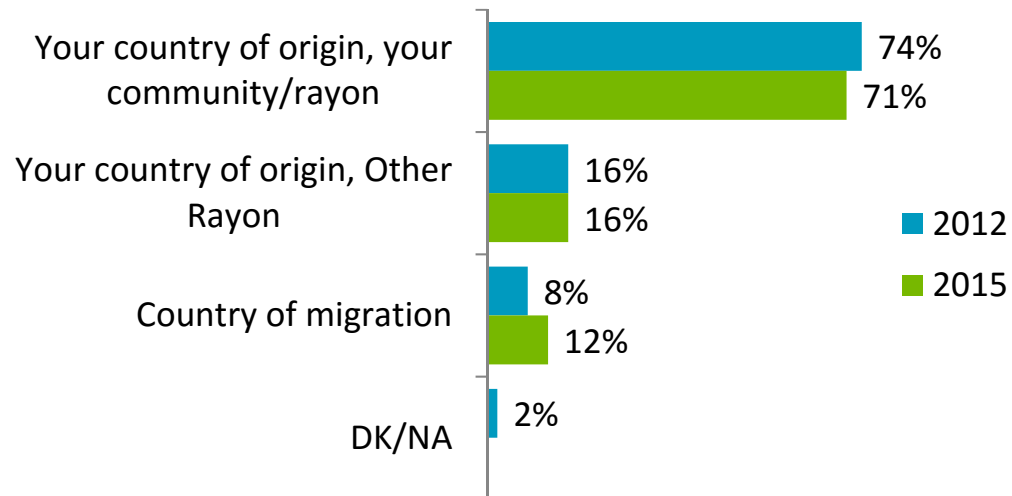

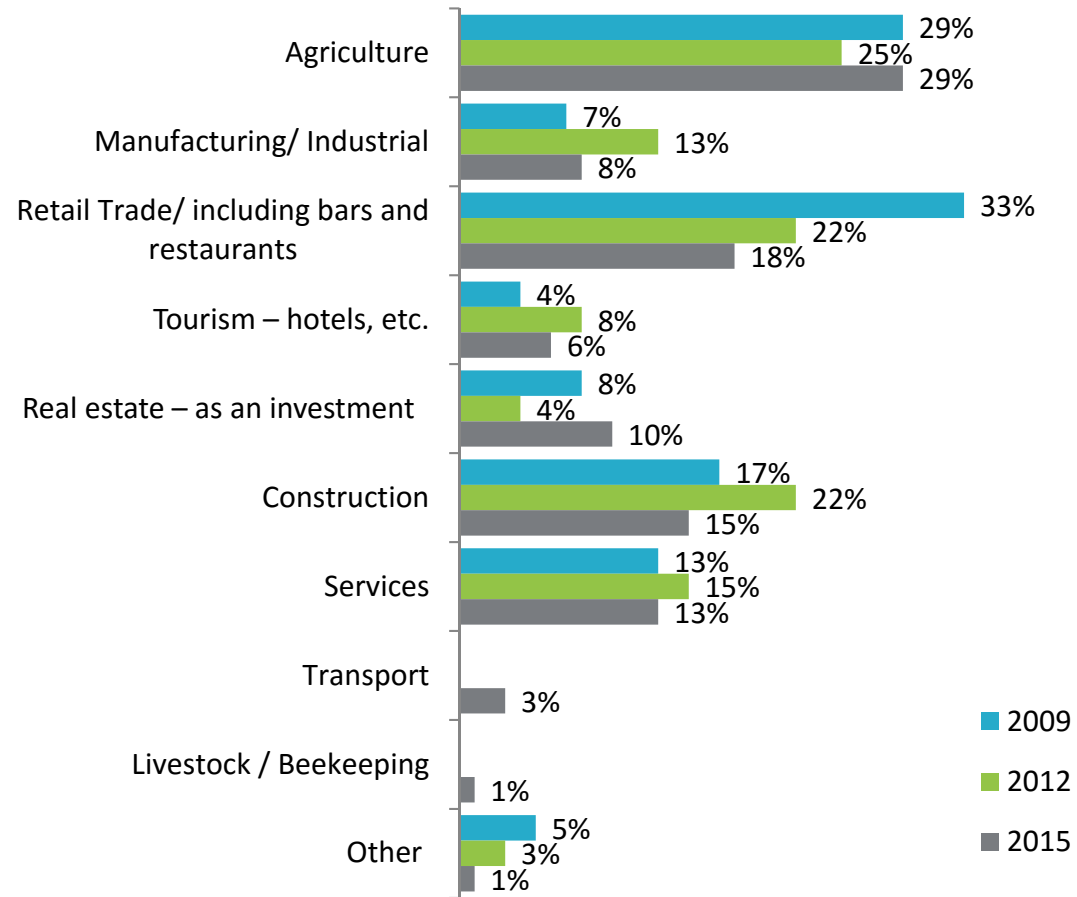


Location of potential investment



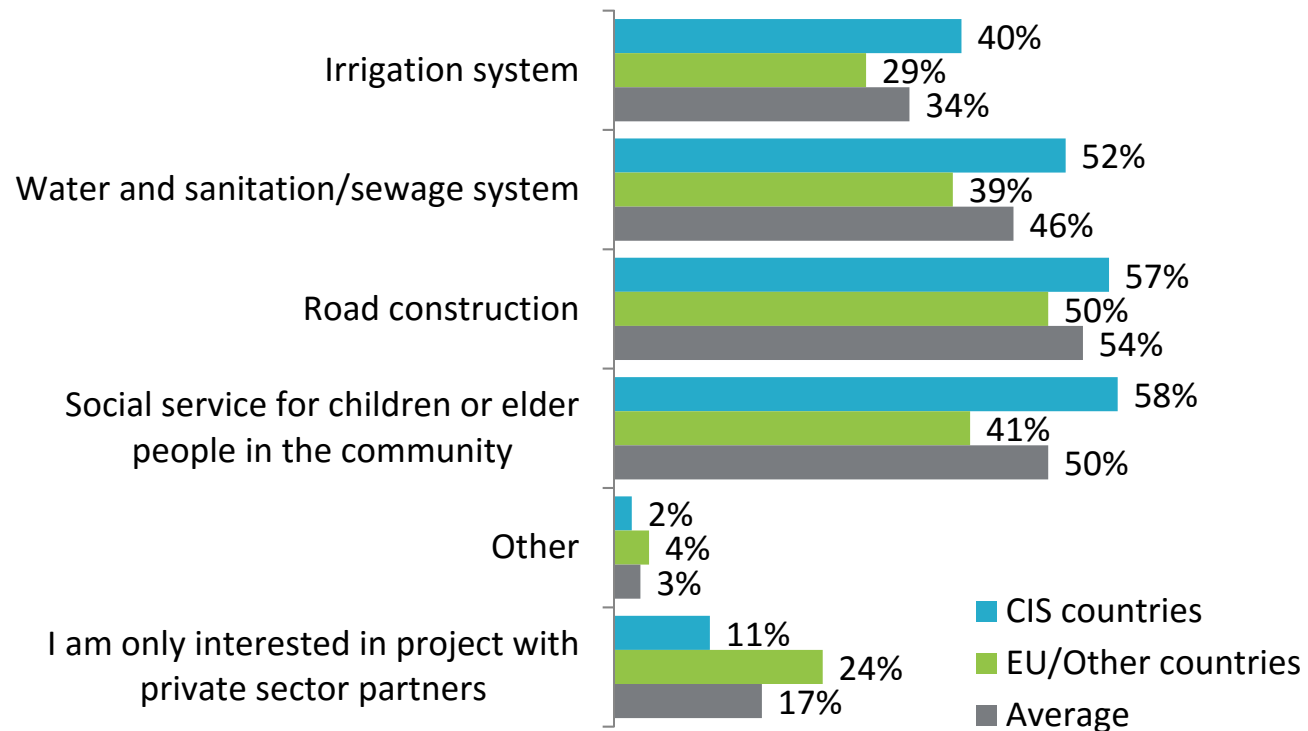
